Spot crocodiles on a Daintree River cruise, learn about flora, fauna and the history of the Daintree on a guided boardwalk tour, take a 4WD ride through a World Heritage-listed rainforest on the rugged Bloomfield Track, visit Cape Tribulation Beach and enjoy a homemade Daintree ice-cream on your journey home.

Your Daintree Rainforest and Cape Tribulation full-day tour from Cairns begins with being met by your friendly accredited guide at your accommodation. After introductions, we drive north along the magnificent scenic coastal route along the Captain Cook Highway learning about the history of the area and admiring spectacular views of the coastline and the Azure waters of the Coral Sea.



Daintree Rainforest River Cruise & Morning Tea - our first stop is at the Majestic Daintree River for a light morning tea (tea, coffee & biscuits) before enjoying an informative guided River Cruise on the Daintree River spotting wildlife. Relax and enjoy the splendour only the Daintree Rainforest can offer as you learn of Estuarine Crocodiles, mangrove forests and endemic wildlife, this is nature at its best!

Stop 2: Alexandra Range Lookout

we make our way up over the Alexandra Range and pause for a panoramic view of World Heritage, Wet Tropics, and Tropical Rainforest merging with the azure colours of the Coral Sea.

Guided Boardwalk Daintree Rainforest Tour - experience the rainforest intimately on one of our guided elevated National Park Boardwalks. Your experienced guide will take you on a wonderful journey through this ancient rainforest whilst giving you an interpretation of flora and fauna and you will have ample time for photographs and questions as we search for the elusive, rare and unique Southern Cassowary and other wildlife species within this particular habitat.

Lunch - enjoy lunch at a local cafe in the Daintree Rainforest region with your fellow travellers. We can cater for most special dietary requirements, please notify our reservations team before travel.

Freshwater Swim - enjoy a refreshing rainforest stream swim, in crystal clear fresh waters without the crowds of people.

Cape Tribulation Beach Walk - stroll along the famous Cape Tribulation Beach and along the boardwalk to the photographers' platform overlooking the mountains and coast where the Rainforest meets the Reef. Itineraries are also subject to change, modification and some destinations may not be reached at the discretion of the Billy Tea Safaris guide on the day due to weather conditions, road conditions, possible road closures, and the safety of all passengers.

Tropical Fruit Ice-Cream - we stop at an exotic homemade ice creamery at the Daintree Ice-Cream Company on the way home. The ice cream is homegrown on the property and is a unique experience, one of the highlights of the day. Signature ice cream cup included.

Daintree Ferry Crossing - cross over the mighty Daintree River via Ferry before returning to your accommodation.

What time does the tour start and end?

Southside Accommodation: pick up 6.50 am

Cairns City (CBD) accommodation: pick up between 7.00 – 7.15am, returns 6.30pm

Northern Beaches accommodation: pick up between 7.20 – 7.45am, returns 6pm

Port Douglas accommodation: pick up 8.20am, returns approx 4.00 – 4.30pm

Please note all times are approximate. Please ensure you are on time for your pick up! If you are not on time, you may miss your pick up which will incur 100% cancellation fee.

How many people will be in the vehicle?

Our vehicles take 16 to 20 passengers only. We keep our numbers small to create a more personalised experience. Note that during busy periods we often have more than one vehicle touring in the Daintree, so you may see a couple of busses out and about!

Can we do a private charter?

Yes! Private charters are available with personalised itineraries and price on application, enquire now!

What do I need to take?

Hat, sunscreen, camera with extra batteries & memory cards, water bottle, towel and swimming costume (if you plan to swim), insect repellent, extra cash for cold drinks, souvenirs or an ice-cream, raincoat in our rainy season or umbrella.

What do I wear?

As we are in a tropical environment, please wear comfortable clothes and flat shoes or sandals. In our winter months (July to August) you may wish to take a light coat/jacket. No thongs (flip flops) or high heels as there is uneven ground and you will be in the rainforest.
